If Mom is ashamed of whatever he might be doing or thinking, a boy learns that he is shameful, probably perverted and corrupt and sick. He learns that he is innately unlovable and must hide half of himself (“if she knew what I was really like, she would despise me!”).

If Dad does not seem to have any of the same issues (because they are never discussed) or seems ashamed or embarrassed by the subject, the boy also learns that it is a shameful thing and there “must be something wrong with him” and he must hide.

What Does “Sex” Men to You?

Is your first image of the sort of people that define “Married” the same as the image of the sort of people that have “Sex”? What about “great sex” or “really hot, steamy sex” or “passionate, romantic sex.” About 85% of people have a “dysfunctional” picture for “married” and a media driven picture for “sex.” Combined with “successful relationship” definitions, it drives many young people to “get sex while it can be good” and to stay in bad relationships.

Another dimension of this question is “what does sex mean to you about you?” and “what does sex mean to you about your relationship?” You can further deepen your exploration by considering different types or levels of sex. “What do quickies mean to you about you? About your relationship?” and “What does awesome, name screaming, mind blowing, body exhausting sex mean to you about you? About your relationship?”
